



Day by day itinerary

Apr 13, Mon:Departure

Apr 14, Tue: Rome- Morning Arrival (AA240 8:05 am)-Vatican Museums- St.Peter's Basilica

Upon landing at Rome Airport, we will pick up our luggage and proceed to be greeted by our tour guide and/or driver. We will start our pilgrimage by visiting the Vatican Museums, containing a group of the most impressive edifices with hundreds of galleries filled with art treasures. See aweinspiring relics, and works of art donated throughout centuries as tributes of faith. We'll cover The Tapestry Gallery, The Raphael Rooms and the most overwhelming Sistine Chapel, Michelangelo's Masterpiece, restored mural of the Last Judgment. Next we make our way back into St. Peter's Basilica. Pope Francis visited the tomb of St. Peter, following his elevation, for a visit of devotion that lasted 45 minutes. He is the first Pontiff to visit the necropolis since extensive archaeological excavations were conducted at the ancient site decades ago. We will also visit the tomb of St. John Paul II located at the Vatican. Check in at the hotel, dinner & overnight.

Apr 15, Wed Rome-Papal Audience-Catacombs-Jubilee

Following breakfast, we will make our way to St. Peter's Square to attend the Papal Audience, led by His Holiness, Pope Francis. (Papal Audience: Is scheduled to take place every Wednesday, pending the schedule of Pope Francis.) Free time for lunch (not included) Following the Audience we will visit the Catacombs where the early Christians hid themselves to escape persecution. The tour will continue with the visit St Paul. Outside the Walls. Continue our tour via the Appian Way -- the oldest road from Roman times--plus the famous Domino Quo Vadis Chapel; see the ancient Baths of Caracalla, Arch of Drusus; Tomb of Celilia Metella. Dinner & overnight in Rome.

Apr 16, Thu: Basilica of St. John the Lateran and St. Mary Major-Holy Steps

Afteer breakfast we will visit the Basilica of St. John the Lateran, the Pope's cathedral church where relics of both Peter and Paul remain under the main altar. It was here that Pope Francis was formally installed as Bishop of Rome. Next we see the Holy Staircase which is believed to be a staircase from Pilate's palace in Jerusalem and brought to Rome by St. Helen in the 4th century. Time permitting we may climb the steps on our knees in memory of Christ's Passion. Continue to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, the most important and the oldest church dedicated to Our Lady. St. Mary Major contains a relic from the Manger of the infant Jesus. At the end of the tour transfer back to the hotel for dinner & overnight.

Apr 17, Fri: Rome-Assisi

After an early breakfast at the hotel, we trasnfer to Assis. Explore the hilltop birthplace of St Francis. In the Crypt of St Francis Basilica laid the tomb of one of the most beloved saints of all the time, St Francis of Assisi. During the tour, our

group will have the opportunity to view a series of frescoes depicting his life, as well as, view a few of the saint's possessions. next we will visit the Basilica of saint Clare and the Crucifix from which Jesus spoke to St Francis. Dinner & overnight in Assisi.

Apr 18, Sat: Assisi-Rome-Medjugorje

After breakfast, we will have free time in Assisi to pray on our own. Then we transfer to Rome airport for our flights to Medjugorje. Upon arrival we will meet our guide/driver then transfer to the village of Medjugorje for dinner & overnight.

Apr 19, Sun: Medjugorje

The most beautiful features of Medjugorje are its simplicity and peace. Over the days in Medjugorje, we may experience our faith grow, and share in the faith journey of pilgrims from all over the world.

Attend Daily Mass: Each morning at 10:00 AM, our group will assemble at St. James Church for Mass (English-Speaking). At the end of each Mass, regardless of language, there is a blessing of the religious articles that you have with you. On Feast Days, and Sundays: English Mass is at 12 PM.

Option A: Climb Apparition Hill: This mountainous hill is where the visionaries first encountered Our Lady. At the base of this hill is a Blue Cross, where it is said Our Lady appeared to the children while they hid from the communist police in the early days of the alleged apparitions. While climbing, our group is invited to recite the Rosary, pausing five times for each decade of the Rosary. At the top of the hill, we will witness the exact location of the first alleged apparition of Our Lady to the visionaries, and enjoy private time for prayer.

Apr 20, Mon: Medjugorje- Krakow

Option B: Climb Mt. Krizevac (Cross Mountain): In 1933, the villagers built a 30' high cross atop a mountain to commemorate Jesus' passion and death on the cross. Your group will have the opportunity to climb this mountain, and venerate that very cross. While climbing, your group is invited to pray the Stations of the Cross (to meditate on Jesus' suffering Road to Calvary), pausing fifteen times for each Station. Transfer to Sarajevo airport to catch our flights to Krakow. Upon arrival we meet our guide/driver transfer to the hotel for overnight.

Apr 21, Tue: Krakow- Wieliczka (Salt Mine)

After breakfast we will explore Krakow's Market Square as the sound of the silver trumpet from St. Mary's Tower fills the air. The captivating beauty of this square is largely due to the fact that it has remained unchanged for almost 700 years. It contains a number of buildings that hold important historic value such as, the Town Hall Tower, the Cloth Hall, and the Burgher's houses. Following our time in this longstanding square, we will make your way to Wawel Hill, where we will visit the beautiful Cathedral, and Coronation Chapel. These are among the most important sites in Poland as the Cathedral has been the coronation site of the Polish monarchs and has

held numerous pieces of Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque, Classicist and Modern art. Also at this site, we will have the opportunity to pray at the tomb of the patron saint of Poland, St. Stanislaus. Continue to Wieliczka and visit Europe's oldest salt mine, which has been listed by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. Return to Krakow for dinner and last overnight.

Apr 22, Wed: Krakow – Auschwitz- Lagiewniki (Shrine of Divine Mercy) - Wieliczka - Krakow

After Breakfast we transfer to Auschwitz, notoriously known as a Nazi concentration camp during the Second World War. While on this visit, we will have the opportunity to view the cell that imprisoned the Christ-like, St. Maximilian Kolbe, and visit the Martyrdom Museum. Then we depart for our excursion to Lagiewniki, the capital of the Divine Mercy. Through the mediation of St. Faustina, Christ passed on the message of Divine Mercy at Lagiewniki. While here, we will have the opportunity to visit the Shrine of Divine Mercy that contains images of the Merciful Jesus, relics of St. Faustina, as well as, the Saint's convent chapel and her Tomb. Visit the Shrine of Divinity, which was visited by Saint John Paul II in 2002. Then we have the opportunity to pray by a relic of Saint John Paul II. Dinner & Overnight at our hotel.

Apr 23, Thu: Krakow- Paris (Highlights)

This morning after breakfast we drive to Krakow airport to catch our flight to Paris. Uppon arrival we meet our guide and driver then start our sightseeing tour of Paris taking in such iconic sights as the Champs Elysées, the Arc de Triomphe, the Grands Boulevards, the Invalides and the Eiffel Tower. Visit the Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal. Continue our tour of Paris in the historic center of the Ile de la Cite and admire Notre Dame de Paris Cathedral. Head back to the hotel for dinner & overnight.

Apr 24, Fri: Paris- Lourdes (by train)

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning departure from the hotel in Paris to the train station in order to catch your train with destination Lourdes. Once arrived check in and accommodation at the hotel. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes.

Apr 25, Sat: Lourdes

Today we will wake up in a small town that is nestled within the Pyrenees Mountains. During our time in Lourdes, we will pray and meditate in yet another site of Our Lady's apparitions. Our Lady first appeared to Bernadette in 1858, and announced herself as "The Immaculate Conception", near the Grotto of Massabielle. During the first two apparitions, little Bernadette prayed the Rosary with Our Lady and left without any exchange of words. During the following apparitions, Our Lady emphasized God's love for us, penance and the necessity of performing acts of penance for sinners. Throughout our time in Lourdes, we will have the opportunity to attend Mass at the Grotto, where Our Lady appeared to Bernadette; watch a video presentation that explains, in detail, the story of Lourdes; drink water from the miraculous spring that has healed many; and submerge yourself in the healing baths. Additionally, you will have the opportunity to experience Christ's unconditional love, as we meditate upon the "life size" Stations of the Cross that overlook the Grotto of Massabielle. Also, while in Lourdes, we will walk in and meditate upon the footsteps of St. Bernadette. We will have the opportunity to see Boly Mill, the birthplace of St. Bernadette, and the an abandoned prison where Bernadette's "Cachot," impoverished family lived. Each evening following dinner, we will have an opportunity to attend the candlelight procession and the Rosary before a restful overnight.

Apr 26, Sun: Lourdes- Barcelona

This morning after breakfast we will travel with a private bus, along the French Pyrenean valleys, crossing the mountain range by way of Andorra. This tiny country has turned into a small commercial enclave. Arrival in Barcellona check in and accommodation. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Apr 27, Mon: Barcelona- Montserrat- Barcelona

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, we will visit -in the very heart of Catalonia- Montserrat, a peculiar geological formation, declared a natural park, picturesque from any angle. Here we will find the Marian Sanctuary of Montserrat with "La Moreneta" Possibility of celebrating or attending Holy Mass as well as renewing wedding vows. In the afternoon continue our tour with a visit of Barcellona including the visit at the Sagrada Familia (availability to be reconfirmed) At the end of the daily tour, transfer back to the hotel for dinner and overnight.
