Day by day itinerary

Nov 5, Thu: Depart LAX

Nov 6, Fri: Naples- Arrival-Transfer to Sorrento.

Upon arrival at Naples International Airport, we will collect our luggage and meet our Guide/Driver, then transfer to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Nov 7, Sat: Naples- Pompeii- Sorrento

After breakfast, we begin our day with a profound encounter at the **Naples Cathedral (Duomo di San Gennaro)**, home to the cherished relics of **St. Januarius**, the beloved patron saint of Naples. Here, pilgrims have the opportunity to venerate his relics and reflect on the centuries-old miracle of the liquefaction of his blood, a sign of protection and intercession treasured by the faithful. We then transfer to **Pompeii**, the ancient city buried by the ashes of Mt. Vesuvius in 79 AD. We walk through one of the most important archaeological sites in the world, exploring preserved streets and homes. We then visit the Shrine of the Rosary of Pompei, "La Madonna del Rosario," one of the most visited Catholic shrines. The venerated painting of Our Lady of the Rosary, with its bronze gilt frame, is displayed on the high altar. The painting depicts the Virgin Mary and Child Jesus presenting the Rosary to Saint Dominic and Saint Catherine of Siena. Inside the shrine are two significant relics of the Passion of Christ: a thorn from the Crown of Thorns and a small piece of the Holy Cross. Dinner & Overnight at our hotel.

Nov 8, Sun: Sorrento area -Amalfi coast- Ravello

Today we tour the Amalfi Coast, widely considered one of the most beautiful coastlines in the world and designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We follow the 34 miles of winding roads, stopping briefly to admire the breathtaking panoramic view of Positano then arrive in Amalfi, one of Italy's four historic maritime republics, where we view the beautiful Amalfi Cathedral dedicated to Saint Andrew. After free time for lunch, we continue to Ravello to visit its Cathedral devoted to Saint Pantaleone and the Villa Rufolo, known for its festivals and magnificent gardens. Return to our hotel for dinner & overnight.

Nov 9, Mon: Sorrento- Capri Island

After breakfast, Full-day visit to Capri. Transfer by minibus from the hotel to the port of Sorrento, departure by hydrofoil for the visit Full day of Capri with a guide, and return to the hotel. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Nov 10, Tue: Late check- Mass in Sorrento- Rome

Today we will have a late check out and Breakfast. Then Celebrate Mass in Sorrento. Afterwards we transfer to Rome. The rest of the day is at leisure. Dinner & overnight at the hotel in Rome.

Nov 11, Wed: Rome – Papal Audience – St. Peter's Basilica – Sistine Chapel

Following breakfast, we make our way to St. Peter's Square to attend the Papal Audience led by His Holiness, Pope Leo, which is scheduled every Wednesday pending the Holy Father's calendar. After free time for lunch (not included), we continue with a guided visit of St. Peter's Basilica, followed by personal free time inside the basilica for private prayer, reflection, or exploring its chapels at our own pace. We then proceed to the visit of Vatican Museum and the Sistine Chapel. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight in Rome. ***Papal Audience is subject to His Holiness' schedule and availability.**

Nov 12, Thu: St. John Lateran – Holy Stairs – St. Mary Major-Catacombs-St. Paul Outside the Walls-Appian Way

After breakfast, we visit the Basilica of St. John Lateran, the Pope's cathedral church, where relics of Saints Peter and Paul rest beneath the main altar. Next, we visit the Holy Stairs, believed to be from the palace of Pontius Pilate and brought to Rome by St. Helen in the 4th century. Pilgrims may climb the steps on their knees in remembrance of Christ's Passion. We continue to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, the oldest church dedicated to Our Lady. Here we venerate the precious relic of the Manger that cradled the Infant Jesus and pause in prayer at the tomb of Pope Francis.

Our day continues with a visit of the Catacombs and then visit of St. Paul Outside the Walls before driving along the historic Appian Way, where we see the Church of Domine Quo Vadis, the ancient Baths of Caracalla, the Arch of Drusus, and the Tomb of Cecilia Metella. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Nov 13, Fri: Rome- Assisi (St. Francis) 1-night Assisi.

After breakfast we transfer to Assisi and we start our visit at the Basilica of St. Francis, visit his tomb, and view frescoes depicting his life along with some of his personal items. We continue to the Santuario della Spogliazione to pray at the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis, the first millennial declared Blessed, known for his deep love for the Eucharist. Next, we enjoy a walking tour through the picturesque town, including the birthplace of St. Francis, ending at the Church of St. Clare, foundress of the Poor Clare Sisters. After free time for prayer, shopping, or lunch, we board the bus to the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels, where St. Francis spent much of his life. Here we visit the Porziuncola, where he founded the Franciscan Order, and the Capella del Transito, the place of his death. We also visit the Rose Garden and the cave where he prayed. Dinner & overnight in Assisi.

Nov 14, Sat: Assisi – Orvieto – Rome

This morning, we ride through the beautiful Umbrian mountains to Orvieto, an incredible town perched on a volcanic rock formation. Here we visit one of Italy's most beautiful and renowned cathedrals. Because of its strategic location, Orvieto's Christian history officially began in 1004, though the city sits atop ancient Etruscan cave tunnels dating back 2,500 years—believed by some historians to have been used by early Christians to celebrate Mass when Christianity was forbidden. Transfer to Rome for dinner & overnight.

Nov 15, Sun: Free day with -Mass celebration.

Today is a free day on our own.

Nov 16, Mon: Colosseum – Trevi Fountain- Farewell dinner

This morning after breakfast we transfer to visit the Colosseum (last entry approx. 4:30 PM). Afterward, we enjoy a dedicated visit to the Trevi Fountain, allowing time for photos and the traditional coin toss. Free afternoon then we have a farewell dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. **Nov 17, Tue: Return Home.**
