Day by day itinerary

Jan 18, Mon: Depart point of origin.

Jan 19, Tue: Arrival- Tel Aviv-Bethlehem

Flight Arrival Guidelines

Recommended arrival time: 2:00–5:00 PM Group bus departure: 5:30 PM from the airport to the hotel.

If you arrive outside the recommended time window, you will be responsible for your own transportation. Optional transfers can be booked with us for an additional fee. Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport, proceed through passport control, collect your luggage, and continue to the arrivals hall, where you will meet our representative holding a Bible Trek Tours sign.

Jan 20, Wed: Bethlehem- Shepherd's Field

After breakfast we visit the birthplace of Jesus which is marked by the Basilica of the Nativity and kneel at the place of his birth in the Grotto of the Nativity. We will also visit the Shepherd's field where the Angel of the Lord proclaimed the good news of the birth of the Savior (Luke 2:8-18). Dinner & overnight in Bethlehem.

Jan 21, Thu: Mount of Olives- Gethsemane- Mount Zion- St. Peter in Gallicantu-Bethlehem

We begin this day after breakfast driving to the top of the Mount of Olives, for a majestic view over all of ancient and modern Jerusalem, the center of the biblical world. The Pater Noster Church and the Chapel of Dominus Flevit (Jesus wept) before walking down the "Palm Sunday Road" to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations (Basilica of the Agony) where Christ prayed on the night of His betrayal (Luke 22:40-46). Next, we drive to the Upper Room, and the Dormition Abbey on Mount Zion. After we visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu (Palace of Caiaphas). Dinner & overnight in Bethlehem.

Jan 22, Fri: Nazareth- Cana- Nazareth Village- Nazareth

After breakfast we leave Bethlehem and drive to Nazareth, where we visit the Grand Basilica of the Annunciation and the St. Joseph Church. Then we visit Nazareth village. Afterwards we continue to visit Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle by turning water into wine at a wedding. Its modest church is a suitable place to reconfirm wedding vows. Dinner & overnight at our hotel in Nazareth.

Jan 23, Sat: The Sea of Galilee-Nazareth

After breakfast we visit the Mount of Beatitudes by the Sea of Galilee overlooking the Jordan Valley. Then we stop at the church of Multiplication (Tabgha) for a visit. Afterwards we continue to the Primacy of Peter where Jesus commanded Peter to "Feed my sheep". Then we proceed to Capernaum to see the remains of an early church, the ruins of Peter's house, and an ancient synagogue. In the afternoon we enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Back to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Jan 24, Sun: Mt. Tabor- Ein Karem- Jerusalem

After Breakfast we drive to Mount Tabor, the Mount of the Transfiguration (Matthew 17:1-8). From the top of the mountain there is a wonderful panoramic view which extends from Mt. Hermon in the north to the hills of Samaria in the south. Afterwards we drive to the town of Ein Karem to visit the shrine of visitation and the birthplace of St. John the Baptist. Dinner & overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem.

Jan 25, Mon: Bethany- Jericho- Baptismal site- Dead Sea-Jerusalem

After breakfast we visit Bethany, the town where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. We then drive to visit the "Qasr El-Yahud" baptismal site on the River Jordan, which the Vatican recognizes as the authentic site of the baptism. There we renew our baptismal vows. We pass through Jericho, with a view on the Mount of Temptation, the place where Jesus spent 40 days and 40 nights in the desert. After we drive to the Dead Sea where we can float on the mineral-rich water. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Jan 26 Tue: Old City- Via Dolorosa- Holy Sepulchre- St. Anne- Pool of Bethesda.

Today is a walking tour within the walls of the Old City of Jerusalem, visiting the Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the man who had been crippled for 38 years (John 5:2-9), and the Church of St. Anne where there is an opportunity to sing a hymn before walking along the Via Dolorosa (Way of the Cross) from Pilate's Judgment Hall to the empty tomb in the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. We will then have a Free time in the old city before returning to our hotel for dinner & overnight.

Jan 27, Wed: Early morning departure

Shrines of France
10 days: Jan 18-27, 2027

Jan 18, Mon: Depart for Paris, France

Jan 19, Tue: PARIS

Upon our arrival in Paris we meet our tour director who will remain with us until the end of our tour. Transfer to our hotel for dinner & overnight. (Depending on flights we can do a city highlight tour before heading to the hotel).

Jan 20, Wed: Paris Highlights- Notre Dame Cathedral- Basilica of the Sacred Heart

Upon arrival, we enjoy a panoramic introduction to Paris before visiting some of its most iconic landmarks. Highlights include the Notre Dame Cathedral visit when restoration is done and the stunning Basilica of the Sacred Heart (Sacré-Cœur) in Montmartre. We will also enjoy the historic streets and atmosphere of this beautiful city before dinner and overnight in Paris.

Jan 21, Thu: Paris-Chartres

Breakfast and check-out. Drive to Chartres (approx. 3 hours). Visit the magnificent Cathedral of Notre-Dame, famous for its medieval stained glass and Gothic architecture. Transfer to the hotel for check-in. Mass celebration and free time at leisure. Dinner and overnight in Chartres.

Jan 22, Fri: Chartres-Nevers

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. We then depart for Nevers, a scenic drive of approximately 3.5–4 hours through the peaceful French countryside. Upon arrival, we visit the Saint Gildard Convent, the place where St. Bernadette Soubirous spent the final 13 years of her life as a sister of Charity. Here, pilgrims can reflect before her incorrupt body, displayed in a glass reliquary—a powerful and moving experience for many. If available, we will celebrate Mass in the Chapel of St. Bernadette (subject to confirmation). Afterward, transfer to the hotel for check-in and some time to rest. Dinner and overnight in Nevers.

Jan 23, Sat: Nevers – Paray-le-Monial – Ars – Lyon

This morning we travel to Paray-le-Monial, the city of the Eucharist, where Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque received visions of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We visit the Chapel of the Apparitions and enjoy a presentation about the Basilica of the Sacred Heart. We then continue to Ars, the village of Saint John Vianney, Patron Saint of Priests. Here, we tour his home and the basilica that houses his incorrupt body, and we celebrate Mass. In the evening, we arrive in Lyon for dinner and overnight.

Jan 24, Sun : Lyon – Avignon – Carcassonne

This morning we visit the beautiful Cathedral of Lyon, where we celebrate Mass. Following Mass, we drive to Avignon for free time for lunch before our visit to the grand Palace of the Popes, where in the 14th century, it served as home to the Papacy during Rome's tumultuous political conditions of the time. Following our time in Avignon, we continue on to the largest preserved walled city in Europe, the ancient city of Carcassonne, for dinner and overnight.

Jan 25, Mon: Carcassonne – Toulouse – Lourdes

This morning we enjoy a walking tour of Carcassonne. Next we drive to Toulouse for a visit the Church of Les Jacobins where we will visit the tomb of Saint Thomas Aquinas, a Doctor of the Church. Following Mass, we continue on to Lourdes, where in 1858, Mary appeared to young Bernadette Soubirous. Upon our arrival in Lourdes we check into our hotel prior to walking to the Sanctuary for an introduction to the Shrine. Following dinner, we participate in this evening's Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Lourdes.

Jan 26, Tue: Lourdes

This morning, we celebrate Mass at the Grotto, where Mary appeared to Bernadette numerous times. Following Mass, we enjoy a walking tour of Lourdes where we will see the places important in the life and story of Saint Bernadette, including the Healing Baths where many pilgrims submerge themselves for its healing properties, the Rosary Basilica (Lower Basilica), the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception (Upper Basilica), the Basilica of Pius X, followed by visits to Bernadette's home and the Museum of Lourdes. Our afternoon is free for personal exploration of Lourdes and time for those who wish to visit the Lourdes' Baths. Following dinner this evening, we have another opportunity to join the Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Lourdes.

Jan 27, Wed: Return home from Lourdes or Toulouse airport.
