Day by day itinerary

Oct 5, Mon: Departure Aug 1, Sun: Departure

Aug 2, Mon: Arrival in Seoul (Incheon International Airport)

Upon arrival at Incheon International Airport (ICN) we proceed to passport control, then collect our luggage and meet with our tour leader and driver. Transfer to our hotel for a restful evening. Dinner & overnight at our hotel. **D**

Aug 3, Tue: WYD Opening Ceremony & Youth Festival Begins (August 3-8)

We begin our day by attending the official World Youth Day Opening Ceremony and Mass, likely held at a major venue in Seoul. This powerful event formally marks the beginning of World Youth Day. In the afternoon, we start exploring the various “Youth Festival” areas, which typically offer an exciting mix of concerts, cultural performances, vocational fairs, exhibitions, and opportunities for reconciliation. As evening falls, we immerse ourselves in the vibrant and joyful atmosphere of the Youth Festival, celebrating our shared faith with young people from around the world. **B**

Note (Aug 3–8): The bus and guide will be at our disposal from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM for use within the city only. Lunch and dinner will be on our own.

Aug 4, Wed: Catechesis & Spiritual Growth

We begin the day by participating in the daily Catechesis sessions—faith formation talks led by bishops from around the world and typically grouped by language. These sessions are a core part of the World Youth Day spiritual experience and help deepen our understanding of the faith. In the afternoon, we have the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation and continue exploring the vibrant Youth Festival, or spend some quiet time in personal prayer. In the evening, we gather as a group to reflect on the day’s catechesis and share the spiritual insights and experiences we’ve encountered. **B**

Aug 5, Thu: Papal Welcome Ceremony

Our morning starts with another enriching Catechesis session, where we continue growing in faith alongside pilgrims from around the world. In the afternoon, we join hundreds of thousands of young people for the highly anticipated Papal Welcome Ceremony, where Pope Leo XIV officially greets the youth of the world. This emotional and powerful event is one of the highlights of World Youth Day. In the evening, we return to the Youth Festival to enjoy performances or exhibitions that inspire and resonate with us. **B**

Aug 6, Fri: Via Crucis (Way of the Cross)

We begin the day with our final Catechesis session, continuing to grow in faith through the guidance of the Church. In the afternoon, we join fellow pilgrims in the deeply moving Via Crucis (Way of the Cross) with the Holy Father. This powerful and prayerful procession invites us to reflect on the suffering and passion of Christ. In the evening, we come together for group sharing and reflection, processing the spiritual impact of this profound experience. **B**

Aug 7, Sat: Pilgrimage Walk to Vigil Site

In the morning, we embark on the traditional Pilgrimage Walk to the designated Vigil site. As we walk together with pilgrims from around the world, we sing, pray, and feel united in our journey. By afternoon, we arrive and settle into our designated area, laying out our sleeping gear and preparing for the evening’s events. That night, we participate in the beautiful Prayer Vigil with Pope Leo XIV, which includes Eucharistic Adoration, testimonies, music, and reflections. We spend the night under the stars, united in hope, prayer, and community. **B**

Aug 8, Sun: Final Mass with the Pope & Dispersal

We wake up at the Vigil site and prepare our hearts for the emotional and powerful Closing Mass with Pope Leo XIV—the culmination of our World Youth Day journey. At the conclusion of the Mass, we hear the exciting announcement of the next host city. In the afternoon, we begin our organized return to Seoul and settle back into our accommodation. That evening, we gather one last time as a group for a farewell dinner, sharing testimonies, final reflections, and perhaps a few tears, as we exchange contact information and celebrate all we’ve experienced together. **Farewell dinner at a local restaurant. B/D**

Aug 9, Mon: Seoul → Busan / Changdeokgung Palace • Haedong Yonggungsa Temple

After breakfast, we enjoy a brief exploration of Seoul, beginning with a visit to Changdeokgung Palace, one of Korea’s most beautiful royal residences and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We stroll through its elegant courtyards and gardens, taking in the harmony of traditional Korean architecture. Then, transfer to Busan (4h30). On the way, visit **Haedong Yonggungsa Temple**, a unique temple in the short line of the sea. Upon arrival, visit Busan, South Korea's second-largest city, a dynamic coastal metropolis that combines modernity with natural beauty. The city is renowned for its picturesque mountains and bustling port, one of the busiest in the world. Busan is also a city of art, where artists flourish freely. Afterward, transfer to a **local restaurant to enjoy dinner** before heading to the hotel for check-in. **B/D**

Aug 10, Tue: Explore Busan

After breakfast, stroll through the **fish market of Jagalchi** – one of the biggest in Asia and at the international market selling all kind of goods. Later on, stroll through **Bosu-dong Book Street**, which has a unique background. It was formed after the independence of Korea as a residential area in the empty space where the previous Gukje Market was demolished. Bookstores began opening one by one, and soon the street became known as Bosu-dong Book Street. Then, **stop at BIFF Square** for shopping or street food. In the afternoon, visit **Yongdusan Park**. In the centre of the park stands **Busan Tower**. Continue to visit **Gamecheon Culture Village** located on the foothills of the mountain and decorated with all type of art from a local community. Finally, visit the **Cemetery of United Nations’ Memorial**, unique in the world as it is managed by the United Nations since 1960. This site pays tribute to the 37,895 members of the UN forces who died during the Korean War between 1950 and 1953. End of the day; take a walk in one of the most popular areas in Busan, **Gwanganlli Beach**, before transfer back to the hotel. **Dinner will be served at a local restaurant. Overnight in Busan.**

Aug 11, Wed: Geoje Island / Geoje POW Camp • Hungnam Evacuation Memorial • Meredith Victory – “Ship of Miracles”

After breakfast, transfer to Geoje Island, located approximately 1h30 hours from Busan, which is the second-largest island in South Korea, renowned for its dramatic coastal scenery, pristine beaches, and historical significance during the Korean War. Upon arrival, beginning the day to visit **Geoje P.O.W. Camp Historic Park** is a park and exhibition hall built on the site of South Korea's largest prisoner-of-war camp, which accommodated up

to 173,000 North Korean and Chinese prisoners captured by the South Korean and UN forces during the Korean War (1950-1953). Afterward, continue to visit **Hungnam Evacuation Memorial** is a commemorative site honoring the 1950 Hungnam Evacuation during the Korean War, one of the largest civilian rescue operations in history. It pays tribute to the thousands of refugees who fled to safety, symbolizing hope, courage, and humanitarian spirit in times of conflict. In the afternoon, transfer to **Meredith Victory Memorial** is a memorial site that honors the cargo ship **SS Meredith Victory** during the Korean War. The ship rescued more than 14,000 refugees in one voyage, becoming a symbol of hope and humanity. Afterward, depart for **Sinseondae Cliff Observatory**, one of Geoje's most spectacular coastal viewpoints. Upon arrival, take a leisurely walk to the observatory deck to admire the dramatic rock cliffs and panoramic views over the deep blue sea. Enjoy time for photography while soaking in the breathtaking scenery of rugged coastline and scattered offshore islands. In the late afternoon, transfer back to Busan and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. **Dinner will be served at a local restaurant.**

Aug 12, Thu: Fly back home from Busan.
