

## Nov 5, Sun: Departure: Houston, TX (IAH) KLM 662 at 3:25 pm

### Nov 6, Mon: Rome: Arrival (FCO airport) KLM 1601 at 11:55 am

Upon arrival at FCO airport Rome we pass through passport control, get our luggage, meet our representative and driver. Transfer to the hotel for check in, spend the afternoon at leisure then dinner & overnight at the hotel.

#### Nov 7, Tue: Rome-Vatican Basilicas

Today we visit St Peter basilica which gathers inside 2000 years of history and famous works of art such as the Pietà by Michelangelo, you will see the most impressive of edifices, galleries, and awe-inspiring relics. Additionally, our group will have the opportunity to visit the Vatican museum to observe the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, Sistine Chapel, and Michelangelo's Masterpiece. Continue to other Basilicas of Rome's Mary Major which contain relic from the manger of the Infant Jesus, The papal Arch basilica ,St. John in Lateran and the Holy stairs from Pontius Pilate's palace of Jerusalem during the time of Jesus. It is also said that this Staircase was brought to Rome by St. Helen in the 4th century. **Nov 8. Wed: Rome-Papal Audience-Catacombs** 

The tour begins with the Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square! This Audience is celebrated each Wednesday by His Holiness, Pope Francis (subject to the holy father's schedule). following the audience visit Vatican sop at the tomb of St. John Paul II. Afterwards, our group will enjoy free time for lunch on our own, or to purchase souvenirs from Vatican City. We will then begin the short journey down the Appian Way, the earliest road of Ancient Rome. This road will lead to the Domino Quo Vadis Chapel, the Baths of Caracalla, the Arch of Drusus, the Tomb of Cecilia Metella, and the catacombs of St. Callixtus. The day concludes with a visit to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. Originally founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th Century, this Basilica is the place of Saint Paul the Apostle.

**Nov 9, Thu: Rome–Monte cassino–San Giovanni Rotunda**Today we will be transferred by bus to Montecassino. This one hour and forty-five minute (approximate) bus ride will be extremely scenic, as we pass through the Roman countryside that is known for its villas and vineyards. Throughout this bus ride, our tour escort will share very interesting information regarding the spiritual, historical, and cultural aspects of Italy. We will arrive in Montecassino, the principle monastery of the Benedictine Order, founded by Saint Benedict around 530 A.D. then we drive (approximately three hours) toward San Giovanni Rotunda, the hometown of Saint Padre Pio.

#### Nov 10, Fri: San Giovanni Rotundo-Monte Siant'Angelo This morning we will see the places associated with Saint Pio.

See his room, confessional and the Crucifix from which Saint

Pio received the Stigmata. Visit the Grotto Michael the Archangel, a shrine consecrated by St. Michael. At this grotto, St. Michael appeared to a Bishop to assure him that his diocese would not be annihilated as he feared. Following the visit to this grotto, our group will enjoy free time for lunch on their own and gaze at the breathtaking view of the ocean and surrounding countryside.

#### Nov 11, Sat: San Giovanni Rotundo-Lanciano- Assisi

Today we will board the bus and head to Lanciano (approximately two hours). Upon arrival in Lanciano, we will celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Longinus. This Church is the site of the Eucharistic Miracle that occurred in the eighth century. At the time of the Miracle, there was a Brazilian monk who struggled with the belief in the real presence of The Lord Jesus in the Eucharist. During the time of Mass, the monk, with doubt in his voice, said the "Words of Consecration" and the bread turned into living flesh, and the wine transformed into live blood. Next we will drive towards Assisi (Approximately three hours), the hometown of St. Francis.

#### Nov 12, Sun: Assisi

Explore the hilltop birthplace of St Francis. In the Crypt of St Francis Basilica laid the tomb of one of the most beloved saints of all the time, St Francis of Assisi. During the tour, we will have the opportunity to view a series of frescoes depicting his life, as well as, view a few of the saint's possessions. next we visit the Basilica of saint Clare and the Crucifix from which Jesus spoke to St Francis.

#### Nov 13, Mon: Assisi–Siena - Florence

After breakfast, we transfer to Siena (approximately an hour and a half). the birthplace of Saints Catherine and Beranrdine . Stroll the Piazza Del Campo, and visit the Cathedral and the Basilica of saint Francis , containing the miraculous consecrated host that remained intact since 1730. next we drive to Florence (approximately an hour and a half).

#### Nov 14, Tue: Florence

Full day in Florence, the art capital of the world and home to superb churches. We soon discover why Florence is the undisputed cradle of the Renaissance era. Here one almost breathes art and culture in its charming medieval streets, in craftsmen's workshops, Renaissance palaces, and the world renowned museums, all found within the downtown area of Florence. The memories of the Medici family are united with the splendor of the works of illustrious artists such as Michelangelo, Leonardo da Vinci, and Botticelli. A highlight will be a guided tour: see the Baptistery of St. John, the religious historic jewel of the city with Michelangelo's Gates of Paradise, so called because of their exquisite beauty; it is believed that the creation of these art pieces marked the beginning of the period to be known as the Renaissance. We see the Piazza della Signoria, the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, Giotto's Bell Tower, and the Basilica of Santa Croce,

yet another masterpiece of Gothic art with the pantheon of famous Italians artists such as Michelangelo and Machiavelli. we visit the Ponte Vecchio and the Duomo, whose magnificent dome was created by Brunelleschi.

#### Nov 15, Wed: Florence-Padua

We drive this morning to Padua (approximately two hours). home of St Anthony patron saint of things lost. visit the richly decorated tomb inside the Basilica. One of the Catholic Church's greatest preachers, his incorrupt tongue is kept in the chapel of Reliquaries. Dinner & overnight in Padua.

#### Nov 16, Thu: Padua – Venice-Padua

Today, we depart Padua and transfer to the magical city of Venice (approximately forty five minutes). our group will enjoy a full day tour of the city paved with water! The tour includes visits to St. Mark's Square, the largest square in the city and the site of many government buildings; the Golden Basilica of San Marco, known for the great mosaics that depict the Old and New Testament of the Bible; and the Bridge of Sigh, a bridge that will bring eternal love to those who drift below it. Dinner & overnight in Padua

**Nov 17, Fri: Return Home** Delta 175 (MXP Milano Italy) departs at 11:00 am

After an early breakfast, we will leave by motor coach and transfer to Milan

airport for return flights home. Delta 1284 arriving Houston IAH TX at 9:12 pm
