Day by day itinerary

June 8, Mon: Depart Boise ID. June 9, Tue: Rome-Arrival

Upon arraval at Rome international airport, we will get our luggage and meet our Guide / Driver, then transfer to our Hotel for dinner & overnight. We need to wake up early to get good chairs to Papal audience.

June 10, Wed: Rome: St. Peter's Basilica - Basilica San Carlo Borromeo - Basilica San Silvestro

After breakfast, we will visit the Basilica of San Silvestro in Capite, which contains the relics of St. Tarcisius, to whom Blessed Carlo had a special devotion. Next, tour St. Peter's Basilica, built on the site where St. Peter the Apostle was martyred. Here, you will have the opportunity to view Michelangelo's Pieta sculpture and pray at the tombs of Pope Benedict XVI and St. John Paul II. After lunch, we will head to the Church of San Carlo Borromeo. It was in this Church that Blessed Carlo's Eucharistic Exhibit was first displayed. Blessed Carlo dedicated himself to creating a website dedicated to cataloguing each reported Eucharistic miracle in the world and maintaining a list of the approved Marian apparitions. Next, we will visit the Basilica of San Silvestro in Capite, which contains the relics of St. Tarcisius, to whom Blessed Carlo had a special devotion. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

June 11, Thu: Catacombs- St. Paul outside the walls-Basilica of St. John the Lateran and St. Mary Major-Holy Steps

After breakfast we will visit will visit the Catacombs where the early Christians hid themselves to escape persecution. The tour will continue with the visit St Paul. Outside the Walls. Then we visit the Basilica of St. John the Lateran, the Pope's cathedral church where relics of both Peter and Paul remain under the main altar. It was here that Pope Francis was formally installed as Bishop of Rome. Next we see the Holy Staircase which is believed to be a staircase from Pilate's palace in Jerusalem and brought to Rome by St. Helen in the 4th century. Time permitting we may climb the steps on our knees in memory of Christ's Passion. Continue to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, the most important and the oldest church dedicated to Our Lady. St. Mary Major contains a relic from the Manger of the infant Jesus. At the end of the tour transfer back to the hotel for dinner & overnight.

June 12, Fri: Rome-Orvieto-Assisi

This morning, we will ride through the beautiful Umbrian mountains to Orvieto. Here, we will visit the Orvieto Cathedral, which houses the holy corporal containing the blood from the Eucharistic Miracle of Bolsena. Bl. Carlo Acutis listed this Eucharistic Miracle of Bolsena as one of 32 Eucharistic miracles on the website that he developed. In the afternoon, we will travel to Assisi for dinner and overnight.

June 13, Sat: Assisi- Visit Blessed Carlo Acutis tomb

After Breakfast we explore the hilltop birthplace of St Francis. In the Crypt of St Francis Basilica laid the tomb of one of the most beloved saints of all the time, St Francis of Assisi. During the tour, we will have the opportunity to view a series of frescoes depicting his life, as well as, view a few of the saint's possessions. next we will visit the Basilica of saint Clare and the Crucifix from which Jesus spoke to St Francis. Dinner & overnight in Assisi.

June 14, Sun: Assisi - Gubbio-Perugia-Assisi

After breakfast, we will drive through the beautiful Umbrian mountains to Gubbio. Enjoy this medieval town with a visit of St. Francis Church. Then we visit the town that has been freed by St. Francis from a terrible fierce wolr who afflicted it. Afterwards we continue to Perugia where St. Francis was imprisoned during 13th century wars – visit the cathedral with the tombs of two popes and Mary's 'ring'. Back to Assisi for dinner & overnight.

June 15, Mon: Assisi-Milan

Following breakfast we will transfer to Milan (approximately 5:30 hours), Uppon arrival we will have a city tour the rest of the day is at leisure. Dinner & overnight at the hotel.

June 16, Tue: Milan- Santa Maria Segreta- Milan Cathedral

After breakfast, visit the historic Santa Maria Segreta, where Blessed Carlo served as a Catechist. This beautiful Church was also the parish of St. Charles Borromeo. Next, visit the Convent of Sant'Ambrogio ad Nemus, where Blessed Carlo received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Afterwards we visit the magnificent Cathedral of Milan. The Milan Cathedral boasts being the largest cathedral in all of Italy. Visit Instituto Leone XIII high school, which Blessed Carlo attended. Blessed Carlo's secular interests consisted of the saxophone & computer science. We will return to our hotel in Milan for dinner and an overnight stay.

June 17, Wed: Milan-Pavia-Milan

Following breakfast, we will embark on a sightseeing journey with a local guide in Milan. We will pray for the intercession of St. Ambrose and St. Charles Borromeo as we visit the sites of their tombs (the Basilica of St. Ambrogio and the spectacular Milan Cathedral, respectively). The Milan Cathedral boasts being the largest cathedral in all of Italy. The duomo houses incredible relics, including a nail from the Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ. After free time for lunch, we will venture to north of Pavia to admire the magnificent church and large monastery of Carthusian Certosa di Pavia. Pavia itself then awaits us to explore its famous covered bridge over Ticino river, the Towers of Pavia historical center, and one of the most famous churches built by a Lombard king in Pavia: San Pietro in Ciel d'Oro. The largest tomb of the three located in San Pietro in Ciel d'Oro contains the remains of St. Augustine of Hippo! We will have time to appreciate this site and venerate the remains of this great doctor of the Church. We will return to our hotel in Milan for dinner and an overnight stay.

June 18, Thu: Return home from Milan


