Day by day itinerary

Jan 18, Sun: Departure From BOS Jan 19, Mon: Arrival- Bethlehem

Upon arrival at Tel Aviv Airport in the afternoon we meet our guide & driver and transfer to our Hotel in Bethlehem for dinner & overnight.

Jan 20, Tue: Bethlehem- Shepherd's Field

After breakfast we visit the birthplace of Jesus which is marked by the Basilica of the Nativity and kneel at the place of his birth in the Grotto of the Nativity. We will also visit the Shepherd's field where the Angel of the Lord proclaimed the good news of the birth of the Savior (Luke 2:8-18). Dinner & overnight in Bethlehem.

Jan 21, Wed: Emmaus Nicopolis- Nazareth- Nazareth Village- Tiberias

After breakfast, we depart Bethlehem and make our way to Emmaus, the village where Jesus appeared to two of His disciples after His death and resurrection. From there, we continue north to Nazareth, the hometown of Jesus. Here, we will visit the majestic Basilica of the Annunciation, built over the site where the Angel Gabriel appeared to the Virgin Mary. We'll also stop at the nearby Church of St. Joseph. Next, we step back in time with a visit to Nazareth Village, a wonderful reconstruction of what daily life would have looked like in the time of Jesus. Afterwards we transfer to Tiberias for dinner and an overnight stay at our hotel.

Jan 22, Thu: The Sea of Galilee- Cana

After breakfast, we begin our day with a visit to Cana, the site of Jesus' first miracle where He turned water into wine at a wedding feast. The modest Church of the Wedding at Cana offers a beautiful opportunity for couples to renew their wedding vows. Next, we drive to the serene Mount of Beatitudes, overlooking the Sea of Galilee and the Jordan Valley. This peaceful hilltop where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. Our journey continues to Tabgha, where we visit the Church of the Multiplication, commemorating the miracle of the loaves and fishes. Nearby, we stop at the Primacy of Peter. We then proceed to Capernaum, known as the home of Jesus during much of His ministry. Here, we'll explore the ruins of Peter's house, the remains of an early church, and a well-preserved ancient synagogue. In the afternoon, we enjoy a peaceful boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. We return to our hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

Jan 23, Fri: Mt. Tabor-Jerusalem

After Breakfast we drive to Mount Tabor, the Mount of the Transfiguration (Matthew 17:1-8). From the top of the mountain there is a wonderful panoramic view which extends from Mt. Hermon in the north to the hills of Samaria in the south. Afterwards we continue to Jerusalem for dinner & overnight.

Jan 24, Sat: Mount of Olives- Gethsemane

We begin this day after breakfast driving to the top of the Mount of Olives, for a majestic view over all of ancient and modern Jerusalem, the center of the biblical world. the Pater Noster Church and the Chapel of Dominus Flevit (Jesus wept) before walking down the "Palm Sunday Road" to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations (Basilica of the Agony) where Christ prayed on the night of His betrayal (Luke 22:40-46). Dinner & overnight at our hotel.

Jan 25, Sun: Old City- Via Dolorosa- Holy Sepulchre- Judgment Hall- St. Anne- Pool of Bethesda

Today is a walking tour within the walls of the Old City of Jerusalem, visiting the Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the man who had been crippled for 38 years (John 5:2-9), and the Church of St. Anne where there is an opportunity to sing a hymn before walking along the Via Dolorosa (Way of the Cross) from Pilate's Judgment Hall to the empty tomb in the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. We will then have a Free time in the old city. Dinner & overnight at the hotel.

Jan 26, Mon: Ein Karem - Mount Zion - St. Peter in Gallicantu

After breakfast we transfer to the town of Ein Karem to visit the shrine of visitation and the birthplace of St. John the Baptist. Afterwards we drive to the Upper Room, and the Dormition Abbey on Mount Zion. Then we visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu (Palace of Caiaphas). Dinner & overnight in Jerusalem.

Jan 27, Tue: Bethany- Jericho- Baptismal site- Dead Sea / (Egypt Extension group will transfer to Taba border) (Holy Land only group will go back to the hotel)

After breakfast we visit Bethany, the town where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. We then drive to visit the "Qasr El-Yahud" baptismal site on the River Jordan, which the Vatican recognizes as the authentic site of the baptism. There we renew our baptismal vows. We pass through Jericho, with a view on the Mount of Temptation, the place where Jesus spent 40 days and 40 nights in the desert. After we drive to the Dead Sea where we can float on the mineral-rich water. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Jan 28, Wed: Return Home from TLV for Holy Land Group.

Egypt Extension:

Jan 27, Tue: Transfer to Taba Border- St. Catherine

After an early breakfast we check out of our hotel and transfer to Taba border between Egypt & Israel (approx. 4hours). After going through passport control and crossing the border, our tour guide from the Egyptian side will meet us, escort us to the bus then transfer to St. Catherine for dinner & overnight.

Jan 28, Wed: Climb Mt. Sinai (Optional) – Visit St. Catherine Monastery – Transfer to Cairo

For those who wish to, we have the option to climb Mount Sinai, the sacred mountain where Moses received the Ten Commandments (Exodus 19:18). The climb can take several hours, and it offers an unforgettable experience at sunrise, overlooking the vast desert. After descending, we visit the St. Catherine Monastery, one of the oldest continuously operating Christian monasteries in the world, home to important religious relics and manuscripts. In the afternoon, we transfer to Cairo for dinner and overnight.

Jan 29, Thu: Cairo-Pyramids

After Breakfast, Private guided tour to visit Memphis, the city of the God Path and the capital of the oldest kingdom in the world to see the Alabaster Sphinx and the Statue of Ramses II. Sakkara, the home of Egypt's oldest pyramid, is constructed in around 2,650 BC. Admire this incredible, stepped structure as you learn how it was built for the Pharaoh Djoser, and enjoy time to explore at leisure. Visit the Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx, an archaeological site on the Giza Plateau, on the outskirts of Cairo, Egypt. This complex of ancient monuments includes the three pyramid complexes known as the Great Pyramids, the massive sculpture known as the Great Sphinx, several cemeteries, a workers' village and an industrial complex. Transfer to hotel & overnight.

Jan 30, Fri: Day 4: Cairo- Coptic Cairo- Possible meeting with Egyptian martyr's families.

Breakfast at the hotel. Start our tour by visiting the Coptic churches, a part of Old Cairo which encompasses the Babylon Fortress, the Hanging Church, the Greek Church of St. George and many other Coptic churches and historical sites. It is believed that the Holy Family visited this area and stayed at the site of Saints Sergius and Bacchus Church (Abu Serga). Then visit the Ben Ezra Sinagog. At the end Visit Al Moez Street, one of the oldest streets in Egypt, El Moez Le Din Allah Street is an eloquent witness for historical Cairo with the various monuments spread along both sides of the street. You can walk along history when you walk in Al Moez Street, the most beautiful Islamic Street in Cairo, Islamic monuments & mosques are on each side of El Moez Street. Transfer to the airport to catch out flight back home.

Jan 31, Sat: Return home from Cairo. (Early morning flight).


