We not only bring you to these hallowed locales...we bring you to the Living-Loving Stones in one on one personal ways where you can see, touch and feel the way one lives in this land of complexity and history.

As members of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulcher of Jerusalem, we are tasked with knowing this is WHO we are and this IS what we do! As your Pilgrimage Coordinators our motto is simple..."we take you on the Pilgrimage, Jesus brings you home." Come and join us now!

Our Daily Itinerary

Nov 30, Mon: Departure Dec 1st, Tue: Arrival - Tel-Aviv

Upon arrival at Tel Aviv Airport, we will meet our representative, proceed to passport control, baggage claims and then meet our pilgrimage guide and driver. Transfer to our hotel in Tel Aviv for dinner and overnight.

Dec 2nd, Wed: Caesarea Maritima-Stella Maris (Mt. Carmel)-Tiberias

This morning after breakfast we leave to Caesarea Maritima, the city and harbor that was built by Herod the Great and the place where Peter baptized the Centurion Cornilios and his household. Afterwards, we leave to Mt. Carmel, Stella Maris to visit the cave where the prophet Elijah once sought refuge. Then we continue to Tiberias for dinner & overnight.

Dec 3, Thu: Nazareth- Cana- Mount Tabor

After breakfast, we drive to Nazareth to visit the Grand Basilica of the Annunciation, the sacred site where the Archangel Gabriel announced to the Blessed Mother that she would conceive the Son of God: "And the Word became flesh" (Luke 1:26). Next, we visit St. Joseph's Church, built over the home of the Holy Family, where Jesus grew up in wisdom (Luke 2:52). We then proceed to Cana, the site of Jesus' first miracle, where He turned water into wine at a

wedding feast. This modest yet significant church is a beautiful place for couples to renew their wedding vows. Our journey continues to Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration (Matthew 17:1-8). From its summit, we take in breathtaking panoramic views, stretching from Mount Hermon in the north to the hills of Samaria in the south. We then return to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

Dec 4, Fri: Caesarea Philippi- Sea of Galilee

After breakfast, we drive north of the Sea of Galilee toward the Golan Heights to visit Caesarea Philippi, where Jesus declared to Peter: "You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church" (Matthew 16:13-19).Next, we return to the Sea of Galilee area and visit the Mount of Beatitudes, overlooking the Jordan Valley, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. We then visit Tabgha, the site of the Church of the Multiplication, commemorating the miracle of Jesus feeding the five thousand. Our journey continues to the Primacy of Peter, where Jesus instructed Peter to "Feed my sheep", reaffirming his role as the leader of the apostles. We then proceed to Capernaum, often called the "Hometown of Jesus", to explore the ruins of an early church, the remains of Peter's house, and the ancient synagogue, where Jesus taught. To conclude our day, we enjoy a private boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, reflecting on the miraculous

moments that took place on these waters. We then return to the hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

Dec 5, Sat: Bethlehem- Shepherd's Field-Hogar Nino Dios-Christmas tree lighting in Bethlehem's Manger Square

This morning, we check out early and depart from the Sea of Galilee, traveling south to Bethlehem. Upon arrival, we visit the Basilica of the Nativity, which marks the birthplace of Jesus. Here, we have the special opportunity to kneel at the Grotto of the Nativity, the very place where Christ was born. Next, we visit the Church of the Shepherds' Field, where the Angel of the Lord announced the good news of the Savior's birth to the shepherds (Luke 2:8-18). We then proceed to our **hotel in Bethlehem** for dinner and an overnight stay. **Dec 6, Sun: Bethany- Jericho-Jordan River-Bethlehem**

After breakfast, we begin our day in Bethany, the town where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead, witnessing the site of this profound miracle. We then travel to Jericho, the oldest city in the world, where we take in a view of the Mount of Temptation, the place where Jesus fasted and was tempted by the devil during His 40 days in the desert. Next, we visit Qasr El-Yahud, the baptismal site on the Jordan River, recognized by the Vatican as the authentic location of Jesus' baptism. Here, we have the special opportunity to renew our baptismal vows, deepening our spiritual journey. We then return to our hotel for dinner and an overnight stay in Bethlehem.

Dec 7, Mon: Mount of Olives-Mount Zion- St. Peter in Gallicantu- SOLEMN ENTRY into Holy Sepulchre

After breakfast, we begin our day at the Mount of Olives, where we take in a breathtaking panoramic view of ancient and modern Jerusalem, the center of the biblical world. Our first stop is the Pater Noster Church, followed by the Chapel of Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. From there, we walk down the Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane, where we visit the Church of All Nations (Basilica of the Agony)—the sacred site where Christ prayed on the night of His betrayal (Luke 22:40-46). We then continue to Mount Zion to visit the Upper Room

(Cenaculum Church), the site of the Last Supper and the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Next, we visit the Dormition Abbey, where tradition holds that the Blessed Mother fell into eternal sleep. Our journey then takes us to the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, built over the Palace of Caiaphas, where Peter denied Jesus three times before the rooster crowed. Later we proceed to our evening SOLEMN ENTRY into the Church of the Holy Check in at our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner & overnight.

Solemn Entry is allowed only if we have a minimum of 40 people in the group including members of the Knights & Dames of the equestrian order of the Holy Sepulchre.

Dec 8, Tue: Old City- Via Dolorosa- Holy Sepulcher- St. Anne We begin our day by walking the Via Dolorosa (The Way of the Cross), retracing Jesus' footsteps from Pilate's Judgment Hall to the empty tomb inside the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. This powerful procession allows us to reflect on Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection. Afterward, we return to the hotel for breakfast before continuing our pilgrimage within the walls of the Old City of Jerusalem. Our journey takes us to the Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the man who had been crippled for 38 years (John 5:2-9). We then visit the Church of St. Anne, renowned for its incredible acoustics, where we have the opportunity to sing a hymn in this sacred space. We return to the hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

Dec 9, Wed: Western Wall- Ein Karem-Israel Museum

After breakfast we visit the Western Wall (Wailing Wall) of the Temple Mount. Then we drive to the town of Ein Karem to visit the shrine of visitation and the birthplace of St. John. Afterwards we continue to the Israel Museum; where we can see the Dead Sea scrolls, the shrine of the book and a model of Jerusalem as it looked during the time of Jesus. Back to our hotel for dinner & overnight.

Dec 10, Thu: Latin Patriarchate meeting- Our Lady of Palestine Mass & Leisure afternoon. Farewell Dinner. Dec 11, Fri: Return Home.
