Holy Land Oct 3-16, 2023

Oct 3 Tue: Depart USA

Oct 4, Wed: Arrival- Tiberias

Upon arrival at Tel Aviv Airport in the afternoon we meet our guide & driver then continue towards Tiberias to check in at our Hotel for dinner & overnight.

Oct 5, Thu: Nazareth- Cana- Mount Tabor-Nain

After breakfast, we drive to Nazareth, where we visit the Grand Basilica of the Annunciation and the St. Joseph Church. Then we stop at Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle by turning water into wine at a wedding. Its modest church is a suitable place to reconfirm wedding vows. We then drive to Mount Tabor, the Mount of the Transfiguration (Matthew 17:1-8). From the top of the mountain there is a wonderful panoramic view which extends from Mt. Hermon in the north to the hills of Samaria in the south. Afterwards we drive to visit Nain; a small village near Mt. Tabor where Jesus helped a widow by waking up her son after being dead. Back to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Oct 6, Fri: The Sea of Galilee

After breakfast we visit the Mount of Beatitudes by the Sea of Galilee overlooking the Jordan Valley. Then we stop at the church of Multiplication (Tabgha) for a visit. Afterwards we continue to the Primacy of Peter where Jesus commanded Peter to "Feed my sheep". Then we proceed to Capernaum to see the remains of an early church, the ruins of Peter's house, and an ancient synagogue. In the afternoon we enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Back to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Oct 7. Sat: Magdala- Akko - Caesarea Maritima- Jerusalem

This morning after breakfast we visit Magdala "Home town of Mary Magdalene"; where we can see a first century synagogue, a complete first century city and remains of a once prosperous fish processing industry. Complete with shops, marketplace, residential areas, and wharf, this is a city where Jesus himself visited and taught. After we drive to Acre (Akko) tour the citadel, tunnel and harbor then continue to Caesarea Maritima, the city and harbor that was built by Herod the Great and the place where Peter baptized the Centurion Cornilios and his household. Then we continue to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner & overnight.

Oct 8, Sun: Bethlehem- Shepherd's Field- Milk Grotto- Banksy Art- Ein Karem

After breakfast we visit the birthplace of Jesus which is marked by the Basilica of the Nativity and kneel at the place of his birth in the Grotto of the Nativity. Then we visit the Milk Grotto, we will also visit some olive wood carvings shop and continue to the Shepherd's field where the Angel of the Lord proclaimed the good news of the birth of the Savior (Luke 2:8-18). Then we see some of Banksy art on the separation wall around Bethlehem. After we continue to the town of Ein Karem to visit the shrine of visitation and the birthplace of St. John the Baptist. Back to our Hotel for dinner and overnight.

Oct 9, Mon: Bethany- Jericho- Baptismal site-Qumran-Dead Sea

After breakfast we visit Bethany, the town where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead (Lazarus Tomb). We then drive to visit the "Qasr El-Yahud" baptismal site on the River Jordan, which the Vatican recognizes as the authentic site of the baptism. There we renew our baptismal vows. We the drive to Jericho, the place where Jesus spent 40 days and 40 nights in the desert, we will go up the Mountain of Temptation on the cable car. Then we drive to Qumran to view the caves where the dead sea scrolls where found. After we drive to the Dead Sea where we can float on the mineral-rich water. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Oct 10, Tue: Mount of Olives- Gethsemane

We begin this day after breakfast driving to the top of the Mount of Olives, for a majestic view over all of ancient and modern Jerusalem, the center of the biblical world. We visit the church of the Ascension, the Pater Noster Church and the Chapel of Dominus Flevit (Jesus wept) before walking down the "Palm Sunday Road" to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations (Basilica of the Agony) where Christ prayed on the night of His betrayal (Luke 22:40-46). Rest of the day free. Dinner & Overnight at the hotel. (Lunch not included)

Oct 11, Wed: Mount Zion- St. Peter in Gallicantu

After breakfast we drive to the Upper Room, and the Dormition Abbey on Mount Zion. After we visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu (Palace of Caiaphas). Rest of the day free. Dinner & overnight at the hotel. **(Lunch not included)**

Oct 12, Thu: Old City- Via Dolorosa- Holy Sepulchre- Judgment Hall- St. Anne- Pool of Bethesda-Dome of the Rock,

Today is a walking tour within the walls of the Old City of Jerusalem, visiting the Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the man who had been crippled for 38 years (John 5:2-9), and the Church of St. Anne where there is an opportunity to sing a hymn before walking along the Via Dolorosa (Way of the Cross) from Pilate's Judgment Hall to the empty tomb in the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Afterwards (depending on visiting hours at the time we continue to visit the Dome of the Rock). Dinner & overnight at the hotel.

Oct 13, Fri: Israel Museum- Holocaust Museum - Western Wall- Hezekiah's Tunnel (City of David).

After breakfast we visit (Yad Vashem) the Holocaust Museum, Israel's official memorial to the victims of the Holocaust. Then we drive to visit the Israeli museum, see the Dead Sea scrolls, the shrine of the book and the model of the city of Jerusalem as it looked like during the time of Jesus. Later we visit the Western Wall and proceed to the city of David for a visit and walk Hezekiah's Tunnel. Back to the hotel

Oct 14, Sat: Ramallah- Taybeh Village

Today we drive to Ramallah to visit Arafat's square, and take a tour around the separation wall. Afterwards we visit Taybeh Village, the last 100% Christian village, where an old house shows us how people lived in ancient times, **visit the museum of Yasser Arafat**, then the Taybeh brewery and the local Catholic Church where we celebrate Mass. Dinner & overnight at our hotel.

Oct 15 Sun: Late checkout, transfer to Old City for some free time, (lunch on your own) Meet with the Bus then drive to Jaffa for a visit and some free time at the port. Then transfer to the airport to catch the fight back home.
