Day by day itinerary

June 8. Mon: Depart point of origin.

June 9, Tue: Arrival-Rome (morning arrival-Trevi Fountain)

Upon arrival at Rome Airport, we meet with our representative and driver, then start our tour with a walking through the Baroque Rome with the famous Trevi Fountain, some free time for Lunch before checking in at our hotel in Rome. Rest of the afternoon at leisure. Dinner & overnight at the hotel.

June 10, Wed: Rome-Papal Audience -Vatican Museums

Following breakfast, we will make our way to **St. Peter's Square** to attend the Papal Audience, led by His Holiness, Pope Leo. (Papal Audience: Is scheduled to take place every Wednesday, pending the schedule of Pope Leo.) Following the audience, we visit inside the Vatican Museums, containing a group of the most impressive edifices with hundreds of galleries filled with art treasures. See awe-inspiring relics, and works of art donated throughout centuries as tributes of faith. We'll cover The Tapestry Gallery, The Raphael Rooms and the most overwhelming **Sistine Chapel**, Michelangelo's Masterpiece, restored mural of the Last Judgment. Next, we make our way back into **St. Peter's Basilica**. We will also visit the tomb of St. John Paul II located at the Vatican. Back to our hotel for dinner & overnight.

June 11, Thu: Rome-Basilicas - Catacombs

After breakfast at the hotel we visit the Basilicas of **St. John Lateran**, the Pope's cathedral church where relics of both Peter and Paul remain under the main altar. Next we see the **Holy Staircase** which is believed to be a staircase from Pilate's palace in Jerusalem and brought to Rome by St. Helen in the 4th century. Time permitting we may climb the steps on our knees in memory of Christ's Passion. Continue to the Basilica of **St. Mary Major**, the most important and the oldest church dedicated to Our Lady. St. Mary Major contains a relic from the Manger of the infant Jesus. Free time for lunch in Rome (not included). After lunch, the tour will continue with visit **St Paul Outside the Walls and the Catacombs** of St. Callixtus. At the end of the tour transfer to the hotel for Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

June 12, Fri: Rome-Tel Aviv-Tiberias

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion airport, we get through passport control then pick our luggage and meet our Guide & driver then proceed to our hotel in Tiberias for dinner & overnight.

June 13, Sat: Nazareth- Cana- Mount Tabor

After breakfast, we drive to Nazareth, where we visit the Grand Basilica of the Annunciation and the St. Joseph's Church. Then we visit Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle by turning water to wine at a wedding. Its modest church is a suitable place to reconfirm wedding vows. We will then drive to Mount Tabor, the Mount of the Transfiguration (Matthew 17:1-8). From the top of the mountain there is a wonderful panoramic view which extends from Mt. Hermon in the north to the hills of Samaria in the south. Back to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

June 14, Sun: The Sea of Galilee

After breakfast we visit the Mount of Beatitudes by the Sea of Galilee overlooking the Jordan Valley. Then we visit the church of Multiplication (Tabgha). After we continue to the Primacy of St. Peter where Jesus commanded Peter to "Feed my sheep". Then we will proceed to Capernaum and see the remains of an early church, the ruins of Peter's house, and the ancient synagogue. After we enjoy a private boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner & overnight at the hotel.

June 15, Mon: Stella Maris-Caesarea Maritima- Jerusalem

This morning after breakfast we leave the Galilee area and drive to Mt. Carmel, Stella Maris; to see the cave where the prophet Elijah used to hide. Then we continue to Caesarea Maritima, the city and harbor that was built by Herod the Great and the place where Peter baptized the Centurion Cornilios and his household. We then continue to Jerusalem for dinner & overnight.

June 16, Tue: Bethlehem- Shepherd's Field- Ein Karem

After breakfast we go to Bethlehem and visit the birthplace of Jesus which is marked by the Basilica of the Nativity and kneel at the place of his birth in the Grotto of the Nativity. Afterwards we visit the church of the Shepherd's Field where the Angel of the Lord proclaimed the good news of the birth of the Savior (Luke 2:8-18). Later on we drive to the town of Ein Karem to visit the shrine of visitation and the birthplace of St. John. Back to the hotel for dinner & overnight.

June 17, Wed: Bethany-Jericho-Baptismal site-Dead Sea

After breakfast we visit Bethany, the town where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. We then drive to visit "Qasr El-Yahud" The baptismal site on the Jordan River, which the Vatican recognizes as the authentic site of the baptism. There we renew our baptismal vows. We pass through Jericho, with a view on the Mount of Temptation, the place where Jesus spent 40 days and 40 nights in the desert. Lunch. Drive to the Dead Sea, where we can float on the mineral-rich water. Dinner and overnight at the Hotel in Jerusalem.

June 18, Thu: Mount of Olives- Gethsemane- Mount Zion- St. Peter in Gallicantu- Old City- Via Dolorosa- Holy Sepulchre- St. Anne-Pool of Bethesda

We begin this day after breakfast driving to the top of the Mount of Olives, for a majestic view over all of ancient and modern Jerusalem, the center of the biblical world. the Pater Noster Church and the Chapel of Dominus Flevit (Jesus wept) before walking down the "Palm Sunday Road" to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations (Basilica of the Agony) where Christ prayed on the night of His betrayal (Luke 22:40-46). Next, we drive to the Upper Room, and the Dormition Abbey on Mount Zion. After we will visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu (Palace of Caiaphas). Then we proceed to our walking tour within the walls of the Old City of Jerusalem, visiting the Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the man who had been crippled for 38 years (John 5:2-9), and the Church of St. Anne where there is an opportunity to sing a hymn before walking along the Via Dolorosa (Way of the Cross) from Pilate's Judgment Hall to the empty tomb in the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Later we will have a farewell dinner at a local restaurant, back to the hotel for overnight.
